The Charles B. Wang Community Health Center (CBWCHC) is a non-profit community based health clinic that provides comprehensive primary care, social services, and health education to the medically underserved, with a focus on Asian Americans in New York City.

The Center is looking to hire a Health Coach for our Community Action on Smoking and Health Project, a project which aims to reduce smoking among CBWCHC patients, increase referrals from community physicians to smoking cessation resources, and change community smoking norms and practices. The project is conducted in collaboration with Asian Americans for Equality (AAFE), the Chinese American Medical Society (CAMS), and NYU Langone Medical Center.

JOB TITLE: HEALTH COACH

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Collaborate with project partners to train health care providers at the Health Center as well as community physicians to deliver smoking cessation services
- Provide smoking cessation counseling to Health Center patients in person or by phone and provide follow-up services
- Coordinate with the Health Center's Internal Medicine team to deliver smoking cessation services during office visits and track patient progress
- Contribute to the development of the social marketing campaign to raise awareness about the health risks associated with smoking
- Work with the Chinese American Medical Society (CAMS) to provide training follow-up with its member physicians
- Recruit new patients to the project and monitor project processes and outcomes
- Review and analyze data and outcomes of smoking cessation services for CBWCHC patients
- Other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Minimum B.A. or B.S. in health education or related field
- Professional proficiency in English and Chinese (Cantonese and/or Mandarin)

- Experience working in a human service or health-related setting.
- Experience delivering education and/or counseling to Chinese speaking patients/community members
- Former smoker preferred, but not required
