ABC's attending psychiatrists evaluate and treat patients while working in a team format with the service's psychologists and psychiatric social workers, providing clinical leadership. Gouverneur is an active affiliate of the NYU School of Medicine and our Department of Behavioral Health is active in education and training. Faculty appointment at NYU is available with opportunity for medical student and psychiatric resident supervision and teaching within this unique program. We also offer a competitive salary. Psychiatrist position in Primary Care – Behavioral Health

The Department of Behavioral Health at NYCHHC's Gouverneur Health is dramatically expanding its collaborative care capacity. Gouverneur, an FQHC, is also the largest diagnostic and treatment center in NY State, located in a fully modernized plant on Manhattan's Lower East Side.

We are seeking a psychiatrist interested in primary care - behavioral health integration to lead in two related endeavors: helping to lead an enhanced team of psychologists, social workers, and RNs as it works in an embedded manner within Gouverneur's adult primary care clinic; and in developing a comprehensive in-house mental health service at Gouverneur's CMS 5-Star rated rehabilitation and skilled nursing facility (SNF).

Activities include adapting and overseeing IMPACT model interventions, doing formal and informal consultations with primary care physicians, leading inservice initiatives and teaching for primary care staff, and doing consultation and multidisciplinary team development in the SNF.

The position is directly reportable to the Director of Psychiatry and Behavioral Health, demands a half-time to full-time commitment at competitive salary rates and includes an NYU School of Medicine faculty appointment. Speaking ability in one of Chinese dialects is preferred.
